


# Welfare Reform Survey

Answered: 140 Skipped: 1



## Q2 Do you agree that welfare reform should be implemented now?



### Q3 Do you want to see a referendum on our membership of the European Union?



### Q4 Thinking nationally, who do you trust the most with the UK economy?


